TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR NON FOOD VENDORS AND FARM MARKETS

Due to COVID 19 social distancing and masks are recommended during Cherry Days.  
Also, there remains the chance we may have to \*cancel this year if the problem escalates.

**APPLICATIONS** must be submitted by May 15. \*You will be notified by June 1 If you are accepted as a Vendor, or if Cherry Days is not able to continue this year.. If your application is late, you MAY be considered if there is space available.

**VENDOR ACCEPTANCE** is based on date application is received, appropriateness & uniqueness of product, and our judgment of whether the product will enhance the overall experience and quality of our Festival. We value our Vendors and wish you all success at our Festival, therefore, we set a limit to the number of Vendors with same or similar product.

**A COLORADO SALES TAX LICENSE** is required and must be **included on your Application**. If you do not currently have this License, it is easy to obtain by going to <https://tax.colorado.gov/sales-tax-account-license>. You must have this license to be accepted.

**SECURITY** will be provided Friday (07/02) and Saturday (07/03) nights from Close to 7 A.M. However, It is your responsibility to secure your booth and goods. The Town of Paonia, The Cherry Days Festival, and The Cherry Days 4-Ever Planning Committee or any individual member will not be held responsible for any damaged or stolen goods.

**ITEMS** not allowed: Guns (including toys) knives, bullets, brass knuckles, tear gas, para-military gear, any pornographic or sexually explicit material, drug paraphernalia (including pipes), darts, street weapons, foul smelling novelties. There are no exceptions.

As noted on Application: Vendors are allowed to sell only those items listed on at time of acceptance. Any items other than those listed must be submitted for approval to the Vendor Coordinator prior to day of Set-Up.

**Pets are not allowed** in the designated festival area, or in vehicles, parking area, or along the streets. This is for the health and safety of your pet, our participants, and attendees.

**FESTIVAL HOURS: These are the times the Park is open to Vendors.(subject to change)**

**Friday, July 2 Downtown Day ... Vendors open at Noon and may stay open until music ends. .**

**Saturday, July 3 Parade Park opens at 11 A.M .... Vendors remain open until dusk or until music ends. Please see note below re Tear-down.**

**Sunday, July 4 Church-In-The-Park. All are welcome to attend. VENDORS will be closed during church service but may open at Noon if desired. Please see note below re Tear-down.**

**EARLY SET-UP** by appointment only Thursday from 4P.M. to 7P.M. Security will NOT be provided Thursday night.

**REGULAR SET-UP**, Friday 7 to \*11 A.M. Plenty of time for Set-up. We request that you pull in adjacent to your space, unload, go park your vehicle, then come back and set-up. Do not leave your vehicle blocking others from accessing their own space.

**ALL VEHICLES must be out of the Park by \*10 AM FRIDAY. NO SET UP SATURDAY OR SUNDAY.** Once the festival has begun on Friday and Visitors are in the Park there will be no vehicles allowed in and no set-up. Don't be late!

**TEAR DOWN:** Saturday 6 P.M Until close, or Sunday afternoon. PLEASE NOTE: There are often problems involved with tear-down. Be respectful of Festival Attendees still on the Festival grounds, in the drive and walkways, at Food Vendors Booths; and other Vendors who need to access their space

**VENDOR PARKING:** Parking is available at the Elementary School one block west of the Park on 5th Street. The limited parking available near the Park is reserved for Festival Activities, Attendees, and YOUR customers.

**RECYCLING:** Containers will be provided. Please use them. Please keep your area clean and organized. Vendor space must be clean before departing.

**CAMPING AND RV PARKING** is not allowed in the Festival area. There is limited RV space in the Elementary School parking lot at 5th and Box Elder (cannot be reserved). There is no fee and there are no hook-ups. There are a number of motels, hotels, B&Bs and camping spots in the area.

**HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT:** I hereby apply for space rental at Paonia Cherry Days Festival. I have read this application in its entirety and understand the provisions for Vendors. I agree to comply with all Terms and Conditions set forth. I understand I will be removed from the Festival without refund if any of the terms set forth are violated, or if any behavior is deemed inappropriate (including drunkenness, drug use, loud music, swearing, etc.). I release and hold harmless the Paonia Cherry Days Festival, the Town of Paonia, and the Cherry Days 4-Ever Committee from any and all liability, including, but not limited to theft, personal injury, acts of war, or act of God. I understand this application does not guarantee a space in the event and that my payment will be refunded if I am not selected. I understand that acceptance does not guarantee sales.
